




What is Carbon Tax?

Carbon Tax is a new tax in response to climate change, aimed at reducing greenhouse gas emissions in a sustainable, cost effective and affordable manner.

The Carbon Tax Act of 2019, which came into effect on 1 June 2019, will be implemented in 2 phases.

 First Phase: 1 June 2019 to 31 December 2022
Second Phase: 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2030

Who is liable?

A carbon taxpayer is a person who undertakes an activity in South Africa which results in GHG emissions as listed in the Carbon Tax Act, subject to their facility having an installed capacity equal to or above the tax threshold.
